

**Creative Quilting. – Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>**

**Afternoon 4 hours 1 -5 pm (Please Arrive by 12:30 and set up your machine)**



**Students should bring:**

Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat (no smaller than 18")

Scissors,

Mechanical pencil

Basic sewing kit. (scissors, pins, etc)

20 small safety pins to pin the quilt.

Sewing Machine in good working order including your instruction book

Free motion or darning foot.

1 open toed foot

1 pkt 70/10 "sharp" needles

1 fat quarter of thin cotton batting. (I like Warm and Natural.)

1 fat quarter of light colored fabric for the backing.

1 spool of smoke YLI monofilament thread

Extension cord

Light box is a plus – Cushion for Chair to sit on is suggested

Be ready to think outside the box and learn to use colored pencils to complete your illustrations. Pam will show you how to develop your free motion quilting design and explain what makes a good quilting design.
